We welcome you to Fort Polk, Louisiana. Our office, School Support Services, is here to assist you with your school transition needs. A Fort Polk School Information Booklet and the current school calendar is available to assist you with enrollment registration. Students are enrolled into schools based upon residential address. Upon receipt of housing or identification of your residential address, please contact us for additional enrollment information, and we can provide the specific school that is zoned for your address. The district does, however, have an "open enrollment" policy that allows students to attend school out of their authorized bus zone with principal's approval and the understanding that transportation will not be provided by the district.

When registering your child, **HAND CARRY** the following items:

- Birth Certificate
- Social Security Card
- Copy of School Records
- Updated Immunization Record
 - Required Immunizations
 - 4 DTaPs (4th one after 4th birthday)

- 3 Polios (4th one after 4th birthday)
- 2 MMR's
- 3 Hepatitis B's
- 2 Varicella (Chicken Pox)
- 1 Meningococcal(MCV4) (11-12 y/o)
- 1 Tdap (11-12 y/o)
